Urbanizacion "El Raso"

El Raso is situated about 10 car-minutes away from the coastal Guardamar del Segura (community centre), right to one of the numerous salt lakes (Salinas) of the region of Alicante. The name of the urbanization is rooted in a for a long time agriculturally used area at that very place. Right in its centre there is an old, - since many years becoming dilapidated Finca, called El Gran Raso. At the moment this place is marking the border between the growing construction- zone at the one side and otherwise a widely branched road network leading directly to the Salinas. Meanwhile this constructed circuit was declared as conflictive, because the minimum distance to the legally

The whole road network symbolizes and reflects a strong hierarchysation of the public space, where the private car takes precedence over every other means of movement. At the same time there must be no one's own home without a inclusive private garage. Right around the 2 to 3 tracking road network including 28 roundabouts, you could cover a distance of 20 minutes by car without repeating the track. The Orientation up to this time is let to your own private experience due to the missing of addresses of streets and houses. The traffic of potential north European customers (mainly British) attracted by a weekend gratis inspection trip interferes in the labor scenery of the construction work, as well as the garden flowers around the swimming pools of the first Colonos (colonists).

The whole phase of construction of the urbanization El Raso (beginning 2001) was arranged for









Terra nullius is a Latin expression deriving from Roman Law meaning "no man's land", i.e. "empty land", applying the general principle of res nullius to real estate, in terms of private

ownership and/or as territory

under public law.

"Quod nullius est id ratione naturali occupanti conceditur." = What belongs to no one, naturally belong to the first occupant.

In Roman law, "Res Nullius' were physical things which "have not or have never had" an owner. Among these were wild animals, fishes, wild fowl, jewels disinterred for the first time, and lands newly discovered or never before cultivated. Also, among things which "have not an owner" were moveables that were abandoned, lands that were deserted, and the property of an enemy.

It was a Roman maxim that the first possessor of a thing becomes the owner by right of occupancy. Occupancy was defined as an individual taking physical possession of something, which at the moment was the property of no man, (res nullius,) with the view of acquiring property in it for himself. (Henry Maine, Ancient Law, H.S.M., January, 1861)

"Whatsoever, then, heremoves out of the state that nature hath provided and left it in, he hath mixed his labor with, and joined to it something that is his own, and thereby makes it his property. It being by him removed from the common state nature placed it in, it hath by this labor something annexed to it that excludes the common right of other men...'

"...As much land as a man tills, plants, improves, cultivates, and can use the product of, so much is his property. He by labor does as it were enclose it from common..." (at 32.)




